

# The Godhead

We believe in one triune God, eternally existing in three persons-Father, Son and Holy Spirit - each co-eternal in being, co-identical in nature, co-equal in power and glory, and having the same attributes and perfections. Therefore, the doctrine of the Trinity is a central fact of our Christian faith. It is also beyond human comprehension and has no parallel in human experience. The three personalities of God are always in absolute harmony, unity and agreement. Yet, the doctrine of the unity makes clear that they are not three separate gods, like three separate human beings such as Peter, James, and John. Accordingly, the true Christian faith is not tritheism, a belief in three Gods (**Deut. 6:4; Matt. 28:19; 2 Cor. 13:14; John 14:10, 26**).
